DD Can be engaged for services under any of the following areas to enhance the capacity of NGO. Core Areas: Health, Education, Human Resource Development, Management, Energy, Environment, Population, Finance, 'Information Communication Technology (ICT)

A. Health

- Public Health Strategy: Designing community-level hygiene interventions.
- Online Health Training: Building digital platforms for remote health worker training and community awareness.
- Hygiene Infrastructure: Technical advisory on sanitation and clean water access projects.

B. Education: Education & Grassroots Empowerment

- Curriculum Development: Designing localized, impactful learning modules for rural and semi-urban settings.
- Teacher Capacity Building: Training grassroots educators in modern pedagogical tools.
- Vocational Integration: Aligning primary education with future livelihood skills.
